| Launch Eureka | In this session, the first of the foundational series, instructional leaders and educators explore and analyze the curriculum to understand how lessons components build toward a comprehensive and in-depth understanding of mathematics. |
| Lead Eureka | This new session for administrators and instructional leaders provides them with information and resources to develop and sustain a successful implementation. |
| Wednesday, June 21 | |
| Focus on Fluency | This session provides teacher-leaders, math coaches, and curriculum specialists with a window into the coherence of the curriculum by illustrating the progression of fluency work across grades. |

| Solving Word Problems | Teacher-leaders, math coaches, and curriculum specialists study and practice solving problems using math drawings, with an emphasis on tape diagrams. |
| Friday, June 23 | |
| Understanding the Major Work of the Grade Band | Participants study the mathematical progression that forms the major work of their grade band. Educators learn how the concepts, terminology, instructional strategies, and models they teach relate to the prior and subsequent grade levels. |
